Each summer, the Appledore tall ships welcome high school students from across Michigan and around the Great Lakes to participate in a summer camp experience unlike any other! Windward Bound participants acquire a new found appreciation of their environment and a deeper understanding of their own potential while being captivated by life aboard a tall ship. Windward Bound sail training voyages are limited to teens 14-18 years old. A limited amount of scholarship funds is available to trainees in the Great Lakes Bay Region of Bay, Midland, Saginaw and Isabella counties.

Voyage 6 - July 30 to August 9 - \$1,375

Oswego, New York to Amherstburg, Ontario to Bay City, Michigan

Voyage 7 - August 20 to August 25 - \$750

Bay City, Michigan to Ludington, Michigan

Voyage fees include (where necessary) ground transportation to/from destination cities and room, board and shore excursions to destinations like Niagara Falls.
